## Key Stage 3

Progress will be tracked against Key Stage 2 Prior Attainment with students getting a progress grade that indicates how well they are doing.

## Key Stage 4

Students will have targets set for them. They will receive both an upper aspirational target and a lower minimum target.

In each report they will be given a predicted grade. This is the grade teachers expect them to get based on current performance. Students should challenge themselves to meet the upper target but should work to ensure that they do not fall below the lower target.

They will also get feedback on their Learning Attributes as shown above.

## Key Stage 5

Students will have one clear aspirational target set for them.

In each report they will be given a predicted grade. This is the grade teachers expect them to get based on current performance. Students should work to meet this target grade.

They will also get feedback on their Learning Attributes as shown above.

## Reporting to parents

Across the year parents and families will receive a series of reports to update them on the progress of their child. In addition each year group will have a parents evening where progress can be discussed with teachers.

Report types:

**Data Report** = Progress data and attitudinal data only

**PT Report** = Progress data , attitudinal data and a Personal Tutor comment

**Mock Grades** = Mock results and target grades reported
